

Nestled between the Great Bear Rainforest Conservancy to the west, and Tweedsmuir Park to the east, the Valley is authentic, pristine wilderness. This 50mile/80km long valley offers a wealth of experiences, tours and activities you won't find anywhere else!

Experience a wide range of adventures, guided or self-guided, including hiking, fishing, wildlife & bear viewing, bird watching, air touring, and visiting the ancient Petroglyphs. Drift the rivers, or venture into the remote alpine to heli-hike or heli-bike. Swim with wild Pacific salmon as they make their way upstream to the ancient spawning beds. In winter, try something extreme: such as heli-skiing and snow machining in the deep powder of the back country.

The Valley enjoys mild coastal temperatures without the rainfall associated with the outer coast. Enormous old growth trees shelter the trails and pathways. Abundant streams and rivers provide spawning grounds for the wild Pacific Salmon. In turn, the treasured Salmon provide nourishment for the rich ecosystems and wildlife. Remote, yet easily accessible, the Valley boasts a paved airstrip and terminal building with daily scheduled flights, deep sea access, and paved road access via Highway 20 reaching across the magnificent Chilcotin Plateau to the heart of the Cariboo.
